All that I ask is that it be NA related and in good taste. Please check your group's web page to make sure I have everything listed correctly. If you find any mistakes email me bob@briefcasebob.com and I will correct them as soon as I open your email. As a matter of fact this goes for any mistakes you find on the website. Under the groups and NA links tabs you will find links for group updates, new group forms, area updates, and a link to check how or if your group is listed on the world website. Please check this out and make corrections if necessary as we are trying to get all of the group information in our region correct. If you see any groups that no longer meet let me or Dawn E. (TBR Regional Delegate) know so we remove them. We don't want to send our members or any newcomers to any nonexistent meetings.

I have added a clean time calculator to our website and I can put our member's clean dates on the same page if you wish. I would only put first name, last initial, home group, and clean date. Example: "Bob T. – Crossroads – 1-18-95". If this is something you want I will need for the groups to give me their members clean time information either by email or a hand written list. The clean dates would be listed by month.

On the "Contact Us" page I have our PO Box, web servant, and the Houston help line listed. I can add our area trusted servants and add a group contact on each group page if you want. The emails will be spam proof. We should do this on the PI and H&I Subcommittee web pages. Again I need your direction. No personal email addresses would be listed. An example would be h&i@nascona.org with a forwarder to a personal email on our server that no one would ever see. Check out the "Contact Us" page on our website to see the email format. We have unlimited email addresses and web space on our web server.

Each subcommittee has its own webpage as well and I would ask that each subcommittee tell me what they want on their web page. All I have done on these pages is to add basic subcommittee information.

I am in the process of adding information to our website at present. For example on the “Documents” page I have our area policy, group and subcommittee report forms. There are different service manuals, NA Literature downloads, and a link to our regional documents. I will continue to add to this page as I find information or NA documents.

The last thing I will do is to add graphics to our website. I don’t believe in copying other websites graphics. So all graphics will be original with the exception of our NA service symbols and I am always open for ideas.

We have 2 other web addresses that point to our old website. These 2 domain addresses should be redirected to point to our new website nascona.org for now and then eventually phased out in order to eliminate any confusion.
